



2022 - 2023 CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The California Association of Leaders for Career Preparation (CALCP) Board of Directors has established Career and Technical Education (CTE) Scholarships for outstanding senior high school students enrolled in CTE programs. The minimum scholarship amount is \$500 and the total number of scholarships will be determined based on the quantity and quality of scholarship submissions.

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

Students must be nominated by an attendee of the 2022 Career Technical Education Conference held on November 16-18 at the Omni Las Palmas Hotel in Rancho Mirage, CA. *Each attendee may only recommend TWO eligible CTE students.*

CTE Scholarships are open to any graduating senior who has enrolled in at least 2 CTE courses and plans to pursue CTE training after high school. This CTE training must result in one of the following:

- An industry certification (CNA, LVN, ASE, etc.) or
- A one-year certificate program or a two-year associate degree, or
- A four-year degree in a CTE major areas of study.

Employment goal must be clearly stated in the student's narrative and address 1) what employment the student intends to seek and 2) how the student plans to obtain related employment once training is completed.

Candidates must be a current California resident, and graduate from a California public, charter, or private secondary schools before July 1, 2023.

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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The California Association of Leaders for Career Preparation has established Career and Technical Education (CTE) Scholarships for outstanding senior high school students enrolled in CTE programs. The minimum scholarship amount is \$500 and the total number of scholarships will be determined based on the quantity and quality of scholarship submissions.

To be eligible to apply for a CTE Scholarship, the applicant must:

1. be nominated by an attendee of the 2022 Career Technical Education Conference held on November 16-18, 2022 at the Omni Las Palmas Hotel in Rancho Mirage, CA. Each attendee may only recommend TWO eligible CTE students.
2. be currently enrolled in a California public, charter, or private secondary school.
3. be a high school senior who will complete at least 2 CTE courses in a single industry sector.
4. meet all of the criteria listed in the application.
5. be in the process of completing or continuing courses in one of the following CTE Industry Sectors:
 - Agriculture and Natural Resources
 - Arts, Media, and Entertainment
 - Building and Construction Trades
 - Business and Finance
 - Education, Child Development, and Family Services
 - Energy, Environment, and Utilities
 - Engineering and Architecture
 - Fashion and Interior Design
 - Health Science and Medical Technology
 - Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation
 - Information and Communication Technologies
 - Manufacturing and Product Design
 - Marketing Sales and Service
 - Public Services
 - Transportation
6. have obtained graduate status before July 1, 2023.
7. have a valid Career and Technical Education occupational goal.
8. state a clear occupational goal in the narrative, what employment the applicant intends to seek and how the applicant plans to obtain employment once the training is completed.
9. state which institution he/she plans to apply and attend for the selected program of study.
10. be a current California resident.
11. The applicant must complete the application package and submit it to the address below. **Application packages must be postmarked no later than Friday, March 3, 2023.**

The minimum scholarship amount is \$500 and the total number of scholarships will be determined based on the quantity and quality of scholarship submissions.

All applicants will be notified of their application status by email in April 2023.



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APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. APPLICATION

- ☐ Download the PDF application. The PDF application is located at www.calcp.org. Make sure you have the latest version of Adobe Reader installed on your computer.
- ☐ Save the PDF to your computer before entering the information.
- ☐ Complete all areas of the application. Handwritten applications are not accepted.
- ☐ Have your teacher read your application for spelling, grammar and complete information.
- ☐ Verify that ALL phone numbers and email addresses are correct. CALCP will use this information to contact you.
- ☐ Print application for submission with your packet.

2. APPLICATION SIGNATURE PAGE AND APPLICATION VALIDATION

- ☐ Include these completed forms in your application package. Make sure ALL four original signatures are included in the application.

3. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION (Two letters are required and they MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH ORIGINAL SIGNATURES.)

- ☐ One letter from a CTE teacher in your career pathway.
- ☐ One letter more personal in nature from a friend, neighbor or community person/mentor who knows your strengths and abilities.
- ☐ Verify that each letter is signed by the person writing the letter.

4. TRANSCRIPT OF CREDITS

- ☐ On your unsealed high school transcript HIGHLIGHT all of the CTE courses you have completed. (Industry Sector must have a minimum of 20 credits.)
- ☐ Have your unsealed transcripts signed by your high school counselor/registrar or have the transcripts stamped with the official school seal. **Original copies only.**

5. Mail your application package (all documents above) to the CALCP Board. Application packages must be postmarked by **Friday, March 3, 2023.**
